
Many people around the world will be celebrating Earth Day on or around April 22. The purpose of the day is to call attention to the Earth and its many wonders and problems.

This year, the theme of Earth Day is Restore Our Earth. Many organizations and individuals will focus on three days of climate action on April 20-22.





## What is air pollution?

Air pollution comes mainly from things we use, such as cars, airplanes, spray cans and manufacturing plants. They release chemicals into the air, which sometimes causes smog in cities. Smog makes it hard for some people to breathe, including kids who have asthma.



## What to do:

- 1. Chop eggs. Mix with next 3 ingredients to make egg salad.
- 2. Lay tortillas flat on plates.
- 3. Spread 2 tablespoons of egg salad in center of each tortilla.
- 4. Place lettuce on top.
- 5. Fold in 2 edges from opposite sides of tortilla so they touch.
- 6. Take one other edge and roll it up. Makes 5 wraps.
