Roles and responsibilities of the president include

- commander in chief.

• elected for a term of four years.

The section explains how the president and vice president will be elected. (This changed in 1804 with the 12th Amendment.)

The president will:

• be a natural-born citizen.

The word "check" has many meanings.

The term "checks and balances" refers to
the limits put on each branch of government
so that one branch cannot overpower
another branch.

"checked" the powers they gave each branch
of government. The writers wanted the
government, sower to be "balanced," or
evenly shared, among the three branches.
They thought checks and balances would
make government safe and secure. They did

not want one branch to threaten our freedom.

### **Passing laws**

For instance, the Congress approves a bill, but it can't become a law unless the president signs it.





The president can veto, or prevent, a law if he or she doesn't want it to pass. But Congress can override the veto by a two-thirds vote of both

the Senate and the House. The Supreme Court might declare a law unconstitutional, even after it has passed.


